It aims to bring together prominent researchers from various institutions and foster a dynamic environment for knowledge exchange in the field of traffic and transportation, focusing on intelligence, efficiency and sustainability in multimodal transport systems. During the workshop, each speaker will give a 20-minute keynote speech, presenting and discussing their latest research findings and achievements.

Topic Targeting better rail-backboned multimodal systems



Introduction

ISROR is committed to strengthening cooperation and promoting knowledge sharing in railway operation and management. The 10th ISROR will focus on more key issues and industry trends, including railway transport planning, rail transit design and urban sustainability, intelligent operation, rail infrastructure management and multimodal transport integration. The two-day conference will consist of opening and closing ceremonies, keynote speeches and a technical visit. Each keynote speaker will give a 25-minute speech followed by a 5-minute Q&A session.



BJTU School of Traffic and Transportation will cover the round-trip airfare for keynote speakers, book and pay for their accommodation and meals in Beijing during their attendance at the conference.

Introduction

Golden School is an overseas academic course programme for Master and PHD students of BJTU School of Traffic and Transportation, which has been held continuously for 12 years. Annually, three to six courses will be scheduled. Each course spans 16 hours and is usually conducted intensively within one week. At the professor's discretion, a break of up to 10 minutes per hour may be arranged. Professors can determine the assessment format according to the course topic. BJTU School of Traffic and Transportation has no specific requirements in this regard. The assessment format can include, but is not limited to, group work, examination, etc. If the professors accept the invitation, BJTU School of Traffic and Transportation will assign a teaching assistant to handle matters such as scheduling the course time, arranging classrooms, managing course registration, compiling grade statistics, tracking attendance, etc.

BJTU School of Traffic and Transportation will cover the round-trip air tickets for lecturers, book and pay for their accommodation in Beijing during the course. Teaching fees will be paid in a lump sum at the end of the course, with a standard amount of RMB 16,000 before tax per course.
